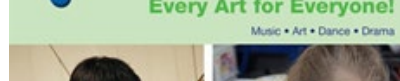

Explore the wonderful world of ceramic art! Create functional hand-built pottery such as bowls, cups, and vases and decorate them with food-safe colorful glazes so you can enjoy using them at home! Develop your creativity as you also create sculptural objects out of clay.

### Coffee House Concert Features Minos on January 12 @ 7 PM



#### Minos Headlines January Coffee House Concert bringing Brazilian cool jazz and pop.

January Coffee House travels below the equator welcoming Minas with a Brazilian blend of smooth sounds expertly merging north and south in a fluid mix of soothing music. Orlando Haddad and Patricia King compose Minas. Their compositions resonate as comparisons to classic by Cole Porter and Antonio Carlos Jobim.

Brazilian guitar and jazz piano weave together in sensual rhythms coalescing with male and female voices entwined with English and Portuguese poetry. Their uplifting music, both subtle and complex, is nuanced beauty able to transport listeners to another realm.

Intuitively, they message Brazilian and American roots distilling sounds that are fresh and innovative, from ballads tinged with melancholic traits of Blues and Choro, to folk coasting on the subtle coolness of a Bossa Nova pulse, to upbeat Sambas elaborated with instrumental jazz improvisation, scat singing and whimsical whistling. Capturing the essence of great songwriting with memorable melodies, inventive harmonies, and poetic lyrics, the music of Minas is timeless.

### DAC Acknowledges Our Gifted Teaching Artists

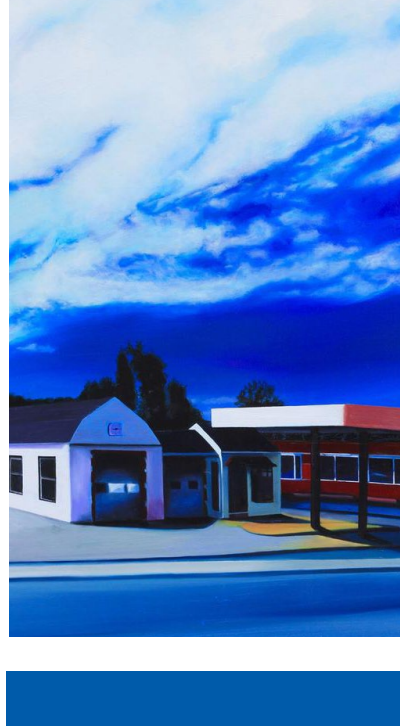


#### Bea Kaplan (Visual Art) (Drawing, Mixed Media, Printmaking)

David Katz is a graduate of the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts. In his recent oil paintings, he explores the country mystique in Chester County as it relates to our human existence via sky paintings. David renders the stillness of the exterior, blending architecture and the landscape as it becomes a playground for the omnipresent sky, drenched in saturated colors or subdued hovering mystically above, benign yet dominant, as if lying in wait, embracing all that lies below.
